Designating the State Agency to undertake functions as envisaged in the Kerala State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Renewable Purchase Obligation and its Compliance) Regulations, 2010 for the period from 01.10.2013 to 30.09.2014.

ORDER

In exercise of the powers conferred under Section 61, 66, 86(1) (e) and 181 of the Electricity Act, 2003, the Commission has notified the Kerala State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Renewable Purchase Obligation and its Compliance) Regulations, 2010.

- 2. Regulation 5(1) Kerala State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Renewable Purchase Obligation and its Compliance) Regulations, 2010 provides as under:-
- "5(1) The Commission shall designate a State Agency for accreditation and recommending the renewable energy projects for registration and to undertake functions under these Regulations".
- 3. The Commission designated Agency for Non-conventional Energy and Rural Technology (ANERT), Thiruvananthapuram as the State Agency for the period from 01/04/2013 to 30/09/2013 as per Order No.1429/CT/KSERC dated 27/03/2013.
- 4. Commission has now decided to extend the period of designation of ANERT as the State Agency as per Regulation 5(1) of Kerala State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Renewable Purchase Obligation and its Compliance) Regulations, 2010 for a period of one year from 01/10/2013 to 30/09/2014. Accordingly, in exercise of the powers conferred under Regulation 5(1), the Commission hereby Designates the Agency for Non-conventional Energy and Rural Technology (ANERT), Thiruvananthapuram to undertake the functions as the State Agency envisaged under the Regulations for a period of one year from 01/10/2013 to 30/09/2014.
